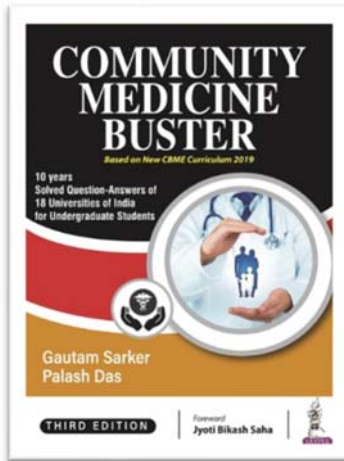

ABOUT THE BOOK

In this edition few chapters are revised like in chapter 1, ICD-11 are incorporated, in chapter 5, oral questions on immunization and vaccine related issues are added, communicable and non-communicable diseases, reproductive and child health, demography and family planning chapters are fully revised. In chapter 6, overview of Covid-19 and available vaccines are described in brief. In chapter 15, guidelines for handling, treatment and disposal of waste generated from Covid-19 patients are also incorporated. In chapter 21, Integrated Disease Surveillance Programme (IDSP) is revised. Apart from that in chapter 22, MCQs (231) are picked up from different universities questions.
